Answer Key

1. **40** Each number on the clock is 5 minutes, so $8 \times 5 = 40$ minutes.
2. **11:05** The hour is 11 and $1 \times 5 = 5$ minutes, so the time is 11:05.
3. **1:15** Quarter past means 15 minutes after the hour, so 1:15.
4. **8:30** Half past means 30 minutes after the hour, so 8:30.
5. **10:45** Quarter to 11 means 15 minutes before 11, which is 10:45.
6. **8** $40 \div 5 = 8$, so the minute hand points to the 8.
7. **20** The minute hand at the 4 means 20 minutes past.
8. **12:20** 12:10 plus 10 minutes is 12:20.
9. **quarter to 5** 4:45 is quarter to 5.
10. **a.m.** You catch the morning school bus happens in the morning (a.m.).
11. **30** half an hour is 30 minutes.
12. **p.m.** The sun sets happens in the afternoon or evening (p.m.).
13. **a.m.** You wake up in the morning happens in the morning (a.m.).
14. **p.m.** You watch the stars come out happens in the afternoon or evening (p.m.).
15. **p.m.** You go to bed at night happens in the afternoon or evening (p.m.).
16. **p.m.** You read a bedtime story happens in the afternoon or evening (p.m.).
17. **7:05** The hour hand is at 7 and the minute hand points to 1 (5 min): 7:05.
18. **15** The minute hand points to 3, and $3 \times 5 = 15$ minutes.
