Answer Key

1. **32** $5 + 3 = 8$ per box. Then $8 \times 4 = 32$.
2. **2** $2 \times 2 = 4$ chairs. Then $4 - 2 = 2$ filled.
3. **1** $7 \times 3 = 21$ dollars. Then $21 - 20 = 1$.
4. **18** $2 \times 5 = 10$. Then $10 + 8 = 18$.
5. **20** $6 + 4 = 10$ per box. Then $10 \times 2 = 20$.
6. **24** $3 + 5 = 8$ per box. Then $8 \times 3 = 24$.
7. **8** $5 \times 5 = 25$, then $- 17 = 8$.
8. **5** $28 - 8 = 20$. Then $20 \div 4 = 5$.
9. **30** $5 \times 5 = 25$, then $+ 5 = 30$.
10. **9** $8 \times 3 = 24$ dollars. Then $24 - 15 = 9$.
