Answer Key

1. **12** $4 + 2 = 6$ per box. Then $6 \times 2 = 12$.
2. **35** $6 \times 6 = 36$ chairs. Then $36 - 1 = 35$ filled.
3. **1** $3 \times 2 = 6$ dollars. Then $6 - 5 = 1$.
4. **30** $4 + 6 = 10$ per box. Then $10 \times 3 = 30$.
5. **48** $6 + 6 = 12$ per box. Then $12 \times 4 = 48$.
6. **10** $4 \times 4 = 16$, then $- 6 = 10$.
7. **3** $15 - 6 = 9$. Then $9 \div 3 = 3$.
8. **12** $5 \times 2 = 10$, then $+ 2 = 12$.
9. **12** $3 \times 5 = 15$ dollars. Then $15 - 3 = 12$.
10. **5** $25 - 5 = 20$. Then $20 \div 4 = 5$.
11. **35** $8 \times 5 = 40$ dollars. Then $40 - 5 = 35$.
12. **12** $3 + 3 = 6$ per box. Then $6 \times 2 = 12$.
13. **2** $5 \times 2 = 10$ dollars. Then $10 - 8 = 2$.
14. **15** $3 \times 3 = 9$. Then $9 + 6 = 15$.
15. **16** $2 \times 4 = 8$. Then $8 + 8 = 16$.
16. **16** $3 \times 4 = 12$. Then $12 + 4 = 16$.
17. **5** $15 - 5 = 10$. Then $10 \div 2 = 5$.
18. **6** $5 \times 4 = 20$. Then $20 - 14 = 6$.
