Answer Key

1. **36** $6 + 6 = 12$ per box. Then $12 \times 3 = 36$.

2. **20** $6 \times 4 = 24$ chairs. Then $24 - 4 = 20$ filled.

3. **2** $7 \times 2 = 14$ dollars. Then $14 - 12 = 2$.

4. **36** $5 + 4 = 9$ per box. Then $9 \times 4 = 36$.

5. **40** $5 + 5 = 10$ per box. Then $10 \times 4 = 40$.

6. **6** $6 \times 3 = 18$, then $- 12 = 6$.

7. **22** $3 \times 5 = 15$, then $+ 7 = 22$.

8. **7** $8 \times 3 = 24$ dollars. Then $24 - 17 = 7$.
