Answer Key

1. **31** $217 \div 7 = 31$.
2. **2** $112 = 5 \times 22 + 2$, so the remainder is 2.
3. **6** $54 \div 9 = 6$.

5. **25** $200 \div 8 = 25$.
6. **12** $51 \div 4 = 12$ remainder 3. So 12 vans are full (with 3 students left over).
7. **9** $54 \div 6 = 9$.
