Answer Key

1. **31** $248 \div 8 = 31$.
2. **2** $86 = 3 \times 28 + 2$, so the remainder is 2.
3. **6** $30 \div 5 = 6$.
4. **24** $144 \div 6 = 24$.
5. **26** $104 \div 4 = 26$.
6. **12** $38 \div 3 = 12$ remainder 2. So 12 vans are full (with 2 students left over).
7. **13** $78 \div 6 = 13$.
8. **18** $54 \div 3 = 18$.
9. **15** $105 \div 7 = 15$.
10. **8** $40 \div 5 = 8$.
11. **5** $7 \times 12 = 84$, and $89 - 84 = 5$.
12. **10** $100 \div 10 = 10$.
