- 18.** Mia ate $\frac{1}{2}$ of 8 grapes. How many are LEFT?

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Answer Key

1. 3 Split 12 into 4 equal groups of 3. Take 1 groups: $1 \times 3 = 3$.

2. 4 $12 \div 3 = 4$.

3. 3 $6 \div 2 = 3$, then $\times 1 = 3$.

4. 4 Ate 2, so $6 - 2 = 4$ left.

5. $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 = 3, $\frac{1}{6}$ of 12 = 2. The larger is 3.

6. 12 $18 \div 3 = 6$, then $\times 2 = 12$.

7. 12 Ate 4, so $16 - 4 = 12$ left.

8. 6 $24 \div 4 = 6$, then $\times 1 = 6$.

9. 3 Ate 3, so $6 - 3 = 3$ left.

10. 2 Ate 2, so $4 - 2 = 2$ left.

11. 3 $9 \div 3 = 3$, then $\times 1 = 3$.

12. 2 Split 10 into 5 equal groups of 2. Take 1 groups: $1 \times 2 = 2$.

13. 3 $9 \div 3 = 3$.

14. 18 $24 \div 4 = 6$, then $\times 3 = 18$.

15. 2 Ate 2, so $4 - 2 = 2$ left.

16. $\frac{1}{2}$ of 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ of 12 = 6, $\frac{1}{4}$ of 12 = 3. The larger is 6.

17. 8 $10 \div 5 = 2$, then $\times 4 = 8$.

18. 4 Ate 4, so $8 - 4 = 4$ left.
