Answer Key

1. **2** $4 \div 2 = 2$, then $\times 1 = 2$.
2. **7** $28 \div 4 = 7$.
3. **6** $18 \div 3 = 6$, then $\times 1 = 6$.
4. **5** Ate 5, so $10 - 5 = 5$ left.
5. $\frac{1}{3}$ of **24** $\frac{1}{4}$ of $24 = 6$, $\frac{1}{3}$ of $24 = 8$. The larger is 8.
6. **8** $20 \div 5 = 4$, then $\times 2 = 8$.
7. **9** Ate 3, so $12 - 3 = 9$ left.
8. **4** $12 \div 3 = 4$, then $\times 1 = 4$.
9. **8** Ate 8, so $16 - 8 = 8$ left.
10. **2** Ate 4, so $6 - 4 = 2$ left.
11. **24** $30 \div 5 = 6$, then $\times 4 = 24$.
12. **6** $12 \div 2 = 6$, then $\times 1 = 6$.
13. **8** $40 \div 5 = 8$.
14. **2** $10 \div 5 = 2$, then $\times 1 = 2$.
15. **3** Ate 3, so $6 - 3 = 3$ left.
16. $\frac{1}{4}$ of **36** $\frac{1}{4}$ of $36 = 9$, $\frac{1}{6}$ of $36 = 6$. The larger is 9.
17. **15** $20 \div 4 = 5$, then $\times 3 = 15$.
18. **4** Ate 6, so $10 - 6 = 4$ left.
