Answer Key

1. $\frac{8}{8}$ Same denominator: add numerators $\rightarrow 8/8$.

2. $\frac{3}{8}$ $7/8 - 4/8 = 3/8$.

3. 1 $5 - 4 = 1$, so the missing fraction is $1/6$.

4. $\frac{5}{6}$ A whole is $6/6$. $6 - 1 = 5$, so $5/6$.

5. $\frac{4}{7}$ $1/7 + 3/7 = 4/7$.

6. $\frac{3}{6}$ $1/6 + 2/6 = 3/6$.

7. $\frac{6}{7}$ $5/7 + 1/7 = 6/7$.

8. $\frac{5}{6}$ $2/6 + 3/6 = 5/6$.

9. $\frac{5}{8}$ $3/8 + 2/8 = 5/8$.

10. $\frac{4}{4}$ $1/4 + 3/4 = 4/4$.

11. $\frac{4}{4}$ $2/4 + 2/4 = 4/4$.

12. $\frac{2}{4}$ $1/4 + 1/4 = 2/4$.

13. $\frac{3}{8}$ $1/8 + 2/8 = 3/8$.

14. $\frac{5}{7}$ $4/7 + 1/7 = 5/7$.

15. $\frac{5}{6}$ $4/6 + 1/6 = 5/6$.

16. $\frac{4}{5}$ $3/5 + 1/5 = 4/5$.
