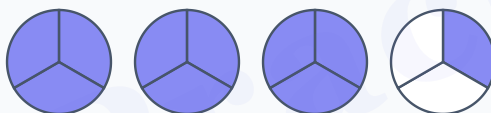

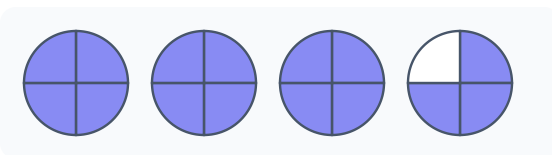

Answer Key

1. $\frac{5}{2} 2 \times 2 + 1 = 5$, so $5/2$.
2. $4\frac{1}{3} 13 \div 3 = 4$ remainder 1, so $4\frac{1}{3}$.
3. **9** $1 \times 6 + 3 = 9$.
4. **24** Each whole = $6/6$, so 4 wholes = $24/6$.
5. **Yes** $7 > 2$, so $7/2$ is greater than 1 (it is $3\frac{1}{2}$).
6. **10** $2 = 10/5$ because $2 \times 5 = 10$.
7. **8** Each whole = $4/4$, so 2 wholes = $8/4$.
8. $\frac{10}{3}$ 3 wholes = $9/3$; plus $1/3 = 10/3$.
9. $\frac{13}{6} 2 \times 6 + 1 = 13$, so $13/6$.
10. $4\frac{2}{6} 26 \div 6 = 4$ remainder 2, so $4\frac{2}{6}$.
11. **3** $1 \times 2 + 1 = 3$.
12. **25** Each whole = $5/5$, so 5 wholes = $25/5$.
13. **Yes** $24 > 5$, so $24/5$ is greater than 1 (it is $4\frac{4}{5}$).
14. **8** $4 = 8/2$ because $4 \times 2 = 8$.
15. **12** Each whole = $4/4$, so 3 wholes = $12/4$.
16. $\frac{15}{4}$ 3 wholes = $12/4$; plus $3/4 = 15/4$.
17. $\frac{7}{2} 3 \times 2 + 1 = 7$, so $7/2$.
18. $1\frac{4}{6} 10 \div 6 = 1$ remainder 4, so $1\frac{4}{6}$.
