Answer Key

1. **0.75** $3 \div 4 = 0.75$.
2. **6** $12 \div 2 \times 1 = 6$.
3. **the fraction $\frac{1}{2}$** $\frac{1}{2} = 0.5$. 0.5 is greater, so the fraction $\frac{1}{2}$.
4. **0.4** $4/10 = 0.4$.
5. **0.5** $2 \div 4 = 0.5$.
6. **7** $35 \div 5 \times 1 = 7$.
7. **the fraction $\frac{2}{5}$** $\frac{2}{5} = 0.4$. 0.4 is greater, so the fraction $\frac{2}{5}$.
8. **0.5** $5/10 = 0.5$.
