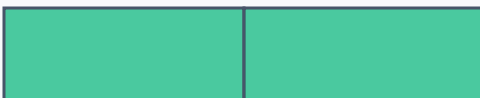

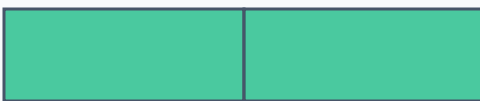

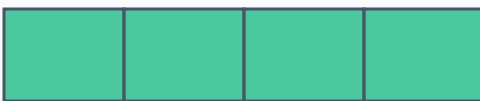

## Answer Key

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1.  $\frac{2}{5}$  Multiply by the reciprocal:  $4/5 \times 2/4 = 8/20 = 2/5$ .
2. **25**  $5 \div 1/5 = 5 \times 5 = 25$ .
3. **3/20**  $3/5 \div 4 = 3/20 = 3/20$ .
4. **42**  $7 \div 1/6 = 7 \times 6 = 42$ .
5. **10**  $5 \times 2 = 10$  pieces.
6.  $\frac{2}{3}$  Multiply by the reciprocal:  $3/6 \times 4/3 = 12/18 = 2/3$ .
7. **40**  $8 \div 1/5 = 8 \times 5 = 40$ .
8. **2/9**  $2/3 \div 3 = 2/9 = 2/9$ .
9. **48**  $8 \div 1/6 = 8 \times 6 = 48$ .
10. **6**  $3 \times 2 = 6$  pieces.
11.  $\frac{25}{16}$  Multiply by the reciprocal:  $5/4 \times 5/4 = 25/16 = 25/16$ .
12. **21**  $7 \div 1/3 = 7 \times 3 = 21$ .
13. **1/3**  $2/3 \div 2 = 2/6 = 1/3$ .
14. **28**  $7 \div 1/4 = 7 \times 4 = 28$ .
15. **16**  $4 \times 4 = 16$  pieces.
16.  $\frac{5}{3}$  Multiply by the reciprocal:  $4/4 \times 5/3 = 20/12 = 5/3$ .
17. **30**  $5 \div 1/6 = 5 \times 6 = 30$ .
18. **1/6**  $1/2 \div 3 = 1/6 = 1/6$ .
