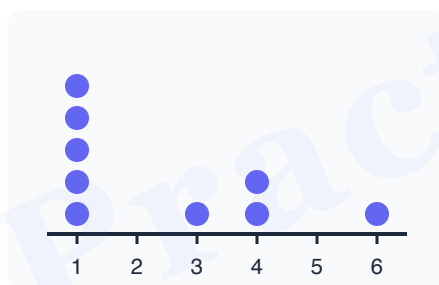

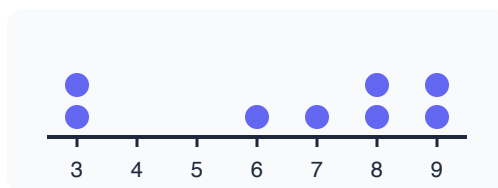

Answer Key

1. **7** Mean = $28 \div 4 = 7$.
2. **21** Order the data: 1, 5, 16, 21, 23, 23, 26. Middle value = 21.
3. **23** Average the two middle numbers: $(21 + 25) \div 2 = 23$.
4. **7** 7 appears most often.
5. **35** Range = $36 - 1 = 35$.
6. **11** Mean = 11.
7. **14** Mean = $70 \div 5 = 14$.
8. **20** Average the two middle numbers: $(18 + 22) \div 2 = 20$.
9. **10** Mean = 10.
10. **27** Order the data: 14, 24, 27, 28, 28. Middle value = 27.
11. **37** Range = $40 - 3 = 37$.
12. **17** Mean = $102 \div 6 = 17$.
13. **27** Range = $31 - 4 = 27$.
14. **4** 4 appears most often.
15. **13** Mean = $78 \div 6 = 13$.
16. **1** 1 has the tallest stack of dots, so it is the mode.
17. **8** Count every dot: there are 8.
18. **7** Mean = $28 \div 4 = 7$.
