2. **Dogs** Cats: 5, Dogs: 4. Dogs has fewer.
3. **Moons** Moons has 3, which is the fewest.
4. **8** In all: $2 + 6 = 8$.
5. **5** 10 flowers – 5 trees = 5 more flowers.
6. **9** Count the pictures in the dogs row: 9.
7. **1** The row for blue cars has 1 pictures, so there are 1.
8. **Circles** Circles: 6, Squares: 1. Circles has more.
9. **Fish** Fish has 2, which is the fewest.
