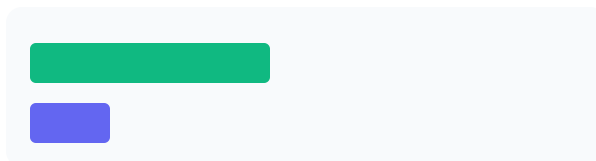

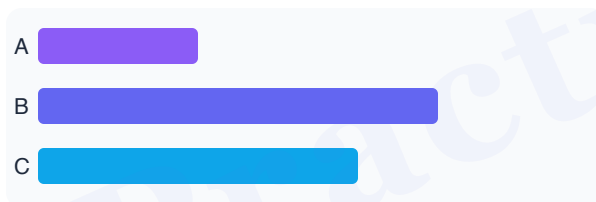

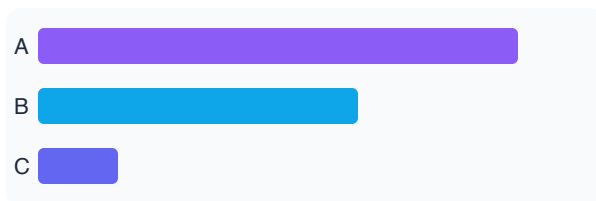

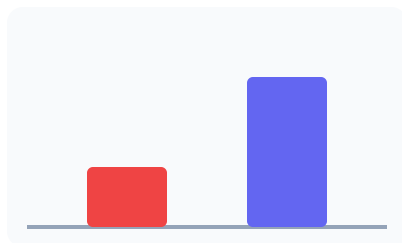

Answer Key

1. **a broom** a broom is longer than a key.
2. **an ant** an ant is shorter than a snake.
3. **a bag of sand** a bag of sand is heavier than a cotton ball.
4. **a sock** a sock is lighter than a suitcase.
5. **a jug** a jug holds more than a thimble.
6. **an egg cup** an egg cup holds less than a watering can.
7. **a lamppost** a lamppost is taller than a mushroom.
8. **a bush** a bush is shorter than a tree.
9. **Top bar** Compare the ends. The top bar reaches farther, so it is longer.
10. **Bottom bar** The bottom bar stops sooner, so it is shorter.
11. **B** Bar B reaches the farthest, so it is the longest.
12. **C** Bar C stops the soonest, so it is the shortest.
13. **Right tower** The right tower reaches higher, so it is taller.
14. **Right cup** The right cup is filled higher, so it has more water.
